OPENING DAY

The school has two terms in a year.

1st term runs from January -June

2nd term runs from June -December.

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS & STUDENTS

The character formation of a student studying at Savannah Plains High School is the duty of all parents, members of the school community, teacher, students and non-teaching staff. These are involved in various ways and capacities to ensure each student is formed well intellectually, socially and emotionally.

Summary of the School Rules and Regulations:

1. Students and Parents must co-operate with the school in the whole process of education.
2. A student must be well-mannered, respect self and others at all times.
3. A student must be present for all classes including the self-study hours.
4. While on campus, a student must **communicate in English** except during Kiswahili.
5. A student must carry out all instructions given by teachers or any other authority.
6. **Cheating** especially in **examinations, stealing, use of alcohol or prohibited drugs, abusive language, pregnancies, disrespect** and any other form of misbehaviour **will not be tolerated.**
Parents/Guardian will be called and disciplinary action will be taken and/ dismissal from the school. **A student is not permitted to bring or use a mobile phone or any electronic device on the school campus.**
7. If a student is absent because of illness or any other reason, she/he must bring a letter to the Principal from parent/guardian explaining the reason of absence, without which she/he cannot be admitted to class. Parent/Guardian may be called in case of frequent absences.
8. If a student is required to leave the school premises before schedule, the parent/guardian must come in person or send a letter stating the reason. No telephone messages will be accepted.
9. **A student is not automatically promoted to the next class, unless the academic progress and behaviour is satisfactory.**
10. Students must be in class daily at 7.05am. Disciplinary action will be taken against habitual late comers.
11. Observe and adhere to rules found in your class/hostel/dining hall and all other school premises.

DIRECTIVES TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

a) HEALTH

PROMOTION CRITERIA

In order to be promoted to the next class and ensure quality of education provided, a student is supposed to work hard and pass all subjects to get at least **60%** in each subject.

If your child does not reach this pass mark he/she will be advised to repeat the class otherwise he/she will have to leave the school.
